

ERGONOMICS COST-JUSTIFICATION WORKSHEET 1

Return on Investment Calculation using Actual Cost Data

If you have information on the cost of injuries associated with poor ergonomics before any changes, and the cost of injuries after ergonomic intervention you can perform a return on investment calculation. You should use the same time-base for the before-and-after comparison (e.g. annual costs, 6-monthly costs, monthly costs).

A) Injury costs before ergonomic intervention	\$

C) Cost of ergonomics intervention	\$

D) Cost savings from Ergonomics Intervention (A – B)	\$
E) Return on Investment ((C/D) x 12) *	months
